Dear Parents and Carers

Unusually this spring term has been a long one, but we've made it to the end! We can see that the children are ready for a break, having worked so hard for the last 13 weeks.

Thank you to everyone for the effort that has gone into the Easter bonnets, they make a marvellous spectacle and I'm sure that you will all enjoy seeing the children on parade later this afternoon. We have two special guests coming to assist us – Mrs Griffiths and the Mad-Hatter! A big thanks also goes out to our Friends of School for organising the event. Please remember to bring some cash along for drinks, cakes and 'Name the Pig', to help raise funds for school.

This week work in school has mainly focused on the Christian festival of Easter, with children learning the story behind it and thinking about Christian symbols. Class 1 did some lovely group work together to make representations of Jesus' cross on the hill. They were able to recount the story and talk about how important the story is for Christians.

Class 2 have also used the cross symbol to create Easter cards. They have linked symbols that we see at Easter to the story, such as eggs representing the stone that was rolled across Jesus' tomb, and the Christian cross symbol coming from Jesus dying on the cross.

As you are aware the government have been focusing on raising school attendance. Today I have been very proud to give out certificates for attendance this term. 37 children were awarded certificates for over 95% attendance and 19 children received 100% attendance certificates. These are wonderful figures, so a big congratulations to you all. Congratulations also goes to our most improved attendee, who has been working really hard to try to come to school every day. Well done!

Over the Easter break we are having some work done to our planters at the front and to the playground, so keep an eye out for changes when we return on **Monday 28th April 2025**.
