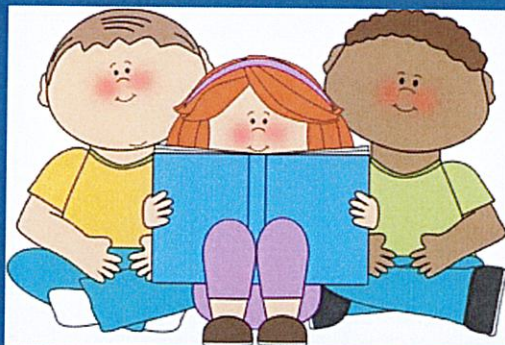

new one.



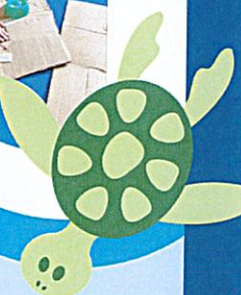

Class 1 enjoyed making a variety of sea creatures to be displayed at the Newport Show in July.

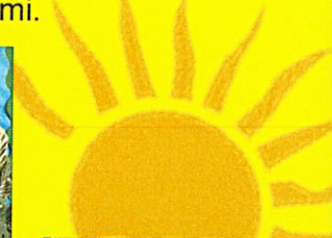


CLASS 2

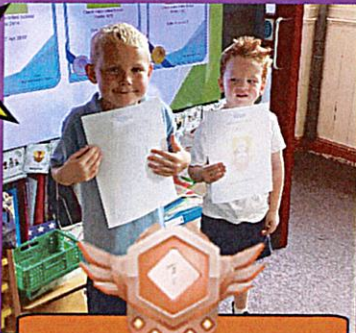
