

Dear Parents and Carers

It has been another busy week. Our work on Peru continues in topic, with children looking particularly at the physical and human geographical features of Peru. They have been very interested in studying maps to identify cities, the Amazon River and the Andes. Mrs Wellman has been a great source of information. She has brought in a piranha to show the children and an insect that is a great snack for children in Peru!

Alongside this work the children in Class 2 have been comparing different versions of the traditional tale, The Princess and the Pea. The Peruvian version is La Princesa and the Pea. This version contains a lovely glossary of Spanish vocabulary which the children have been keen to learn. Class 1 children have been comparing the nursery rhyme of Mary had a Little Lamb to Maria had a Little Llama. This has also fitted in well with our science work on animals as well as Peru.

In science the children have been categorising animals, thinking about carnivores, herbivores and omnivores, and studying the different features that animals have. I have been amazed at the information the children take on board and can recall.

We had a visitor in school this week to look at our SEND provision. She gave us positive feedback about what goes on for children in school and was particularly impressed with how well the children could talk to her about their learning and their aspirations for future careers.

The warm weather looks set to continue next week, so please ensure that your child has suncream applied, brings a hat and a water bottle. We will make sure that they have regular drinks and time in the shade.
