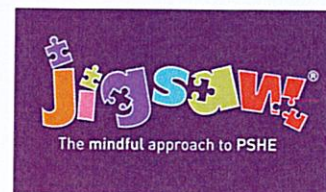


Punctuality - lost learning

Dear Parents and Carers

This week we have really started to see some changes in the children as they are beginning to prepare for their next year group. As well as friendships continuing to blossom, we've had a few fallings out, which always happens at this time of year when the children start to outgrow their year group. We are working with the children on the upcoming changes through our PSHE Jigsaw work and encouraging the children to talk to each other and us about their feelings and any issues they may be experiencing.



Class 1 got all muddy this week whilst making their Peruvian pots. They learnt how to make coils and join them together to build pots. They are drying out nicely now and next week we should see the finished articles as they plan to decorate them.

Class 2 have continued their science work on animals by exploring food chains. They have had lots of discussion around who eats what and where some of our food comes from. The children were able to talk confidently about producers, consumers and predators. It is great to see them connecting their learning to the world around them.



This morning the education team from the Newport Show came to harvest our potatoes that have been growing at the front of school. We remain hopeful that we win the competition at the show next weekend, so please keep your fingers crossed for us!

We have some more produce growing at the front of school (apples and pears) and we have noticed that some children are keen to pick them. We have spoken to the children about not picking them until the autumn, so please could I ask you to support us with this before and after school. Thank you.

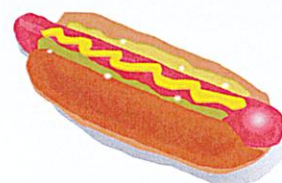
**Reception and Year 1 only** – Invoices and After School club booking form—We will send out invoices for July when we return in September along with the new After School Club booking form for the Autumn term.

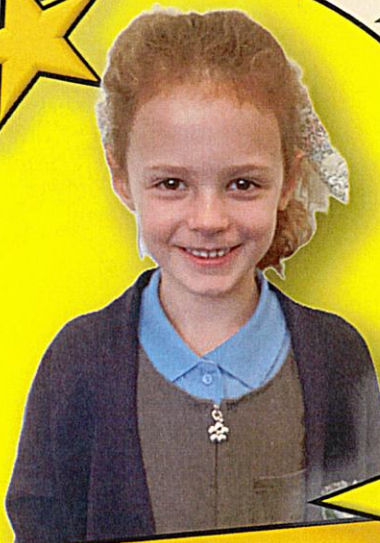
